LIFEJACKETS (PFD'S)

Lifejackets are required to be worn at all times once on one of the sailboats. The student should purchase a suitable lifejacket (Type II, III or V) or you may use one of the school's life jackets. NOTE: This is a policy of both ASA and our Sailing School. The student may opt out of this requirement by signing a waiver.

You will then drive under the Parkway and then exit to your right again and proceed east and proceed past Highway 3. Continue driving until you see the Hilton Hotel and the Lake. After you see the lake and pass the Hilton you will pass 6 red lights and take a right at the 6th light. Our school is on your right as you enter the Marina right across from the Subway restaurant. The Marina's name is Lakeside Yachting Center.

FLEET

We are very proud of our fleet of sailboats. From the 22' MacGregor to the 42' Hunter Waypoint we have a wide variety of sailboats to use for classes and charters. As with all recreational activities we strive to keep our class prices as low as possible in order to serve a wide spectrum of interested sailors. Our fleet, all originally constructed in the 80's is well maintained by a local diesel maintenance company as well as cleaned by a local service company. Should you have any concerns about the boats please let me know or you can call our cleaning company, Terry's Cleaning, at 254-498-6185 with any issues you have.

MEAL PLAN AND FOOD:

The meal plan is to cook on the boat starting the first evening. Based on the schedule we will shop local after day one or you should come prepared with your meals as explained in the intro email to the students. We will decide that the week of the class. Please contact me via email so we can advise of the final plan. Your meal plan should include your fellow crew as well as the Captain. You may eat or drink anything you prefer. We have found that SOUP or STEW are not good compliments for cruising. Solid food has been found preferable by students. It is required that each student cook on the boat.

You should have the information on the class, your book, information on the ASA and other data to be reviewed from your BKB class. You should read and be prepared to discuss the entire book, focusing on all sections of the book, Also, please review the logbook for BCC.

NECESSARY ITEMS FOR A PLEASANT TRIP:

Please be sure to bring plenty of water (ONE GALLON PER PERSON PER DAY), ice, a hat, sunscreen, lipbalm, sailing gloves and a change of clothes and sunglasses. This time of year the weather is uncertain so pay attention to the 77586 zip code weather on the internet to see if there is any front in place. Also, please be sure to wear boat shoes (top sidlers/deck shoes). They lessen slipping and also are better on the boat's deck vs. tennis shoes. Also, your toes must be covered. During summer months one ice chest should be taken for ice/water. Students should coordinate who will bring the ice chest.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Students are responsible for slip fees. This is about \$15 per student. Should we anchor out there is no slip fee charge.

OUR CLUB AND BENEFITS:

As a point of information, our Sailing Club, Club Riviera, which started over 20 years ago, is designed for those students who want to continue sailing. As we have seen through the years, many students feel the need for continued training; hence we have the club that offers unlimited sailing and refresher courses with unlimited mentor sessions. You can come as often as you like to both the classes and group sails offered so be sure to ask about it. Also, the locked showers and restrooms, swimming pools, tennis courts and other amenities of the Yacht Club are part of the membership along with UNLIMITED kayaking, windsurfing and sunfish sailing. The only requirement is that you drive down. The sails to the Bay, Lake and Gulf as well as parties and group outings have become a favorite of our members. Our schools and clubs have been on the lake since 1988 having fun in the sun and on the lake; we look forward to having you with us.

ROWING, KAYAKING, CANOE USE, SAILING, SKIING, BOATING AND PADDLING RELEASE, WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, AND REFUND POLICY ("AGREEMENT") between member and guests, user and guest, renter and guest, student, guest or charterer EITHER BAREBOAT OR CAPTAIN CHARTER ("USER"/"I") and Coggin Consulting, Inc., Sunset Charters, Lets Go Sailing, the Houston Rowing Club, the Lakeside Sailing School, All Points of Sail Sailing School, Club Riviera, Southwest Kayak Rentals, and/or the Lakeside Sailing Club, AND USED D/B/A'S ("Clubs")

IN CONSIDERATION of being given the opportunity to participate in any way in any rowing, sailing, club party, club function, skiing, boating, water activities and/or paddling activities ("Activity"), USER enters freely into this legally binding contract.

USER for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin, as well as any minor's parent and/or legal guardian agree to and: 1. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that USER understands the nature of Rowing, Sailing, Skiing, Boating and Paddling Activities, both on water and land based, and that USER and/or my minor children am/are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity and that I will abide by all prevailing terms, conditions and policies of the SCHOOL AND Club a copy of which is maintained on the premises.

2. FULLY UNDERSTAND that; (a) ROWING, SAILING, SKIING, BOATING, WATER AND PADDLING ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis, and death ("Risks"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the Releasees named below; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages USER or my minor children may incur as a result of my or my minor children's participation in the Activity. USER understands this activity requires strong swimming ability. I hereby authorize any medical treatment deemed necessary in the event of injury while participating in any activity of the SCHOOL AND/OR Clubs;

3. AGREE AND WARRANT that USER will examine and inspect each Activity in which USER takes part as a USER or charterer of the Clubs and Schools (aka Sunset Charters, Coggin Consulting, Inc., The Houston Rowing Club, the Lakeside Sailing School, The Lakeside Sailing Club and Club Riviera and All Points of Sail Sailing School, Seagoing Classrooms) or any other entity affiliated with those clubs/businesses/schools and that if USER observes any condition which USER considers to be unacceptably hazardous or dangerous USER will notify the proper authority and will refuse to take part in The Activity until the condition has been corrected to USER'S satisfaction;

USER will be vigilant to changes in weather conditions and will not launch when storm activity is apparent or predicted in the local area. USER will at all times carefully inspect any and all rowing, sailing, skiing, water and paddling equipment which USER intends to operate before leaving the docks. Personal items should be left at home or in your car. Cell Phones, Personal Equipment and other personal items are the responsibility of the student/member. There will be no reimbursement for personal items lost/damaged or destroyed. Where equipment appears deficient or damaged in any way, USER will note this on the sign out sheet, advise Clubs management and return equipment to storage. I agree that as USER, USER IS responsible for damage and/or loss of any equipment or boat in my possession. **USER'S signature on page one elects to opt out of the schools requirement of wearing PFD's at all times in a vessel.**

7. FULLY UNDERSTAND that equipment is made available only to persons who have been certified to row, sail, water-ski, general water activities or paddle by a Club instructor OR that USER and USER'S guest and minor children am/are capable of such activity without such instruction. Should USER bring a guest, USER will insure that this certification has occurred or that USER'S guest is qualified to participate in any activity. USER may agree to not take a certification course before USER'S guest are allowed to use any rowing, sailing or paddling equipment and USER insures the USER and guest are capable of all activities. USER will be personally responsible for my guests and minor children as well as any equipment which they or USER chooses to operate and will return such equipment to its designated storage as a courtesy. 8. FULLY UNDERSTAND that USER is responsible to reimburse the Clubs for any damage to equipment caused by USER'S guests or USER and that USER IS required to sign out every time USER launches and that failure to do so may result in loss of membership or use of equipment privileges. 9. FULLY UNDERSTAND that safety is of primary concern to the Clubs. USER agrees to call 713-408-1318 if USER has any questions. If USER has an emergency, USER agrees to contact the proper authority: 911, Clear Lake Shores Police @ 281/334-1034, Rowing Management @ 713-408-1318 or Marina Management @ 281/334-1511. 10.
